What will our communities lose if Comcast's proposal is accepted?

CTV will lose its **operating grant**, which supports:

- Coverage of local parades, concerts, festivals, news, high school and college sports
- Access to training and equipment, including CTV's studio and production trucks

Why does Comcast pay our communities?

Comcast pays for use of the public right-of-way, as outlined in their franchise agreement with our ten cities. The company then passes this cost on to subscribers.
